A database is a searchable collection of information. Each database contains 100's of different sources, which you search at the same time. You can cover a lot of ground quickly using databases, finding information from books, encyclopedias, journals, magazines and videos. Most have read-aloud and translation features.

Images & Media includes images, streamed video and music that can be searched by topic.
